How to enrol

We welcome your application. Please send your completed Application for Enrolment to the college address, along with all necessary documentation (see below). Following this, a personal interview with the Head of Primary or Head of Secondary Coordinator will be arranged for you and your child. Admission is subject to approval by the College Council. All applicants will be informed in writing of their success or otherwise.

An Enrolment Deposit (non-refundable) of \$100 per family is required on submission of the Application for Enrolment. This deposit will be deducted from the Tuition Fees when the student commences at the college.

Documentation

Copies of the following documents are needed by the college to support your application for a place for your child:

- Birth Certificate
- Previous school reports
- Immunisation history statement
- Legal documents relating to special family circumstances, eg. AVO
- Passport and visa, if applicant or parents are not citizens of Australia.
- NAPLAN results
- Board of Studies Number (if entering in Year 10 or above)

How much will it cost?

Fees

Tuition Fees for 2020 fee schedule are:

- Pre-Kindy
 - 5 days per week \$1,900 per term
 - 4 days per week \$1,520 per term
 - 3 days per week \$1,140 per term
 - Years K-6\$595 per term
 - Years 7-11\$775 per term
 - Year 12\$1,033 per term for 3 terms
- (Fees are to be met by the second week of each term.)

Discounts

Discounts apply for K-12 Tuition only

- Prompt payment of term fees – 2.5% of tuition
- Payment of fees for full year – 10% of tuition
- Family discounts will be applied to any family where two or more children are attending:
 - Two children..... 15%
 - Three children 30%
 - Four children..... 40%
 - Fifth child free

Other Charges

- **Enrolment Deposit**
(Non-Refundable but is deducted from fees on commencement at college) \$100 per family per year
- **Pre-Kindy Bond** (Refunded at end of year or on deregistration) Equivalent of 4 weeks tuition with 4 weeks' notice in writing to deregister.
 - Attending 3 days per week \$456 (one off payment)
 - Attending 4 days per week \$608 (one off payment)
 - Attending 5 days per week \$760 (one off payment)
- **Consumables Fee**
(Stationery/Equipment/Incursions) To be paid on registration day.
 - Pre-Kindy \$110 per student per term
 - Years K – 5 \$140 per student per year
 - Year 6 \$160 per student per year
- **Subject Levies**
 - Years 7 – 11 \$115 per student per term
 - Year 12 (3 terms) \$153 per student per term
- **Elective Subject Fee**
Some elective subjects may incur an additional fee.
- **Laptop Fee**
 - Years 10 – 12 \$50 per student per term
- **Pre-Kindy Sport Fee**
Charged to Pre Kinders enrolled for Sport days during Swimming, Gymnastic/The Arts and Athletics terms.
\$45 per Pre Kinder terms 2 – 4 only
- **Bus Fee**
 - Zone A bus route (1 – 5 km from the school) \$312 per term
 - Zone B bus route (over 5 km from the school) \$416 per term
- **Music Tuition**
Where elected

(These are the charges listed for 2019. All charges are subject to change each year.)

Special Cases

A small number of places are available for students whose parents cannot meet the total cost of fees. The terms of admission of children in these circumstances are entirely at the discretion of the College Council.

Scholarships

- **Scholarships are available for students in Years 4 - 12 in the following areas:**
 - Academic
 - Sport
 - The Arts
 - Service
- **What standard is expected for scholarships?**
Students awarded a scholarship will be students of exceptional ability. Only students who are able to fit the criteria for the scholarships will be awarded such.
